The Directive 2002/95/EC aims to severely reduce the amount of polluting materials (lead, mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE) in electrical and electronic equipment.

Products using non-compliant components cannot be put onto EU market after July 1st, 2006 without violation of the European law.

All Carlo Gavazzi Manufacturing Companies have already implemented a RoHS compliant project structure in order to eliminate these hazardous substances from the processes and from the products.
